The course begins with a familiarisation session designed to give each driver an understanding of the principles of EV technology, as well as an understanding of controls unique to their vehicle, the instrumentation and charging systems, and the factors that may impact on battery range.

Most of the course duration is spent in an on-road coaching session. Our trainer will help your drivers to tune into the driving characteristics of their EV, and help them to adapt their driving style to optimise efficiency, developing techniques such as

- Maximising the use of regenerative braking to maintain battery performance
- Using early observation to avoid incidence of harsh acceleration and braking, maintaining the vehicle's momentum
- Planning ahead and allowing for appropriate charging opportunities

At the heart of this course are established eco-driving techniques that promote smooth, relaxed progress, irrespective of the vehicle type. The course is therefore also suitable for drivers of hybrid vehicles: The combination of EV knowledge and eco-driving techniques helps drivers to save on fuel by optimising the use of electric drive, reducing the need for petrol assistance.

The course will be delivered by an Approved Driving Instructor, who will come to a location to suit you and your business; delegates attend in their own car or van.
