


PARKING AND MANOEUVRING




Don't rush
as you might overlook hazards

Avoid end bays
where others could swing into you



Open a window
and turn off the radio

Find a tree
or wall to park alongside



Get out
and check the space around you if you're unsure

Watch out
for vehicles that might need more space to load

Have I got enough space to complete the manoeuvre safely?


What stationary and moving hazards should I be aware of?
