Alcohol awareness

Drink-driving is one of the most serious dangers to road safety, and those convicted of the offence can expect severe penalties. This talk dispels some of the myths around alcohol, providing important information and lifestyle tips to help drivers keep their drinking and driving separate.



Night driving

After dark, even familiar routes can look very different, and drivers must employ a specific set of skills to gather information on developing hazards. In this talk, drivers will learn some tips for adapting their observations for safer night driving.



Fatigue

Tiredness is one of the biggest causes of workplace injuries, and the consequences of driving when tired can be severe. This talk helps drivers to understand and identify the factors that can contribute to driver fatigue, and suggests strategies for managing them.



Carrying out regular vehicle checks, and knowing what to check for, not only helps keep drivers safe but also helps them avoid the inconvenience and expense of breakdowns. This talk also touches on ways to check the condition of the most important component of all: the driver.

Speed

For those who depend on their driving licence, avoiding fines and endorsements is a major concern. Inappropriate speed is also the cause of many incidents and contributes to the severity of collisions. This talk helps drivers to better understand speed limits and offers tips for managing speed.



Winter driving

Help keep your drivers safely mobile whatever the weather. This seasonal talk reminds drivers of the challenges of driving in a British winter and prepares them with some strategies for driving in a range of adverse conditions.



All drivers face distractions, both from inside and outside the vehicle, but at-work drivers are especially at risk. This talk helps drivers to recognise the sources of distraction, and shares tips for minimising the effects of distraction and maintaining focus on every drive.
