




HAVE YOU CHECKED YOUR TYRES?

PRESSURE

Make sure your tyres have the correct pressure. You can find this information in the vehicle handbook and on the inside of the fuel filler cap or driver's door sill.



TREAD

Ensure that your tyres have a tread depth of at least 1.6mm. Remember that this is a legal minimum and a newer tyre with deeper tread will perform much better in wet conditions.




CONDITION

Cracks and bulges in a tyre's sidewalls indicate damage: the tyre should be replaced even if the tread depth is still within the legal limit.



OVERLOADING

Overloading your vehicle can cause excessive heat and wear on your tyres. Ensure that your vehicle's overall weight does not exceed its Gross Vehicle Weight rating - found on your VIN plate.



Business drivers and fleet managers need to ensure that all the tyres on company vehicles are fit for purpose, including those on company cars and grey fleet.
