

Driver behaviour - the challenge for fleets

Running a vehicle fleet is a big-budget category for businesses and many of the unforeseen costs incurred are the result of driver behaviour. They are rarely included when setting annual budgets and the ad-hoc nature of occurrence also means that they can be overlooked when considering the total cost of vehicle ownership. These costs typically fall into three categories:

- unexpected damage to vehicles (including 'hit while parked' incidents)
- reduced operational efficiency caused by vehicle downtime
- the cost of employee downtime

Analysing just a small element of the latest industry data highlights the scale of the challenge facing UK businesses of all sizes. It is unfortunate that this comes at a time of unprecedented legislation changes and rapidly improving vehicle technology; two factors that are hindering the fight to control the spiralling costs of corporate mobility.

Parking and manoeuvring

The skill of manoeuvring your vehicle is one thing; being able to assess your surroundings is another. Many city-centre and residential property developments have parking spaces set at the minimum legal size, meaning space can be very tight for some vehicles. This increases the risk of 'hit while parked' incidents; already a major contributor to accident management claims. Our training course will equip your drivers to minimise the risk by employing the full spectrum of parking skills.

- Selecting the optimum space for their vehicle
- Improving awareness of the hazards that may pose a risk of damage to their vehicle
- Selecting the correct parking manoeuvre for the circumstances
- Developing competent reversing and parallel parking techniques





As a business driver, the combination of long distances and tight time schedules dramatically increases the risk of a prosecution for speeding. The numbers of drivers attending Speed Awareness Courses are now at record levels and in many cases, business drivers are attending in work time, meaning a minimum of half a day of lost productivity, paid for by their employer. Our course will help your drivers develop the ability to avoid such a situation.

- Understanding and awareness of speed limits
- Judgement of speed and stopping distance
- Appropriate use of speed (as taught on our Advanced Driver course)



Managing distractions

Many business drivers put their lives at risk every day by failing to manage distractions. Increasingly, drivers juggle two phones for personal and business use, while simultaneously using sophisticated in-vehicle infotainment systems. The latest Killed and Seriously Injured (KSI) statistics show that driving on business is by far the UK's most dangerous workrelated activity. If not managed correctly, distractions can pose considerable risk to your employee, your brand and your business. Our training course will help your drivers to develop a proactive approach to dealing with distractions.

- Identifying and managing the various types of in-vehicle distraction
- How to stop safely in emergency situations
- The power of observation, anticipation and planning
- Maintaining focus amid distractions from outside the vehicle

Additional Skills Development Sessions

We know that the landscape of people who drive on business is changing. Your business drivers may include those who only drive occasionally, those who are relatively inexperienced, and perhaps others who have previously been involved in incidents. Based on the same mix-and-match principle we also offer Skills Development Sessions covering the following topics.

Hotorway driving

Many business drivers cover high motorway mileages every year, without ever having had any training on how to use these unique, high-speed roads in a safe and effective way. This session covers all aspects of motorway driving, helping to minimising the risks and reduce driver stress.

🔎 Overtaking

Regardless of speed, overtaking is arguably the highest-risk driving manoeuvre. To be carried out safely, overtaking requires careful planning, anticipation and spacial awareness skills. This session teaches drivers how to identify safe overtaking opportunities, and to use correct road positioning and speed management to execute the manoeuvre efficiently and legally.

Driving in towns

Congestion, complex road layouts, and an abundance of vulnerable road users such as pedestrians and cyclists can make urban roads particularly challenging, especially at peak traffic times. This session helps drivers to approach and deal with these challenges in a planned and effective way.

Driving on country roads

Over half of road fatalities occur on rural roads. Drivers who are unfamiliar with countryside roads will benefit from this course, learning how to anticipate hidden hazards, and to use observation and road positioning to deal safely with horses, farm traffic and other rural road users.
